1. Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding: for the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold. Prov.3:14,15

2. My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life. Prov.5:20-23

3. He that despiseth his neighbor sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy is he. Prov.14:21

4. He that handleth a matter wisely shall find good: and whoso trusteth in the Lord, happy is he. Prov.16:20

5. A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones. Prov.17:22

6. for as he thinketh in his heart, so is he: Prov.23:7

7. Open rebuke is better than secret love. Prov.27:5

8. Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he. Prov.29:18

9. And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth. Lk.12:15

10. Search the Scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. Jn.5:39

11. Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. Jn.8:31,32

12. I have showed you all things, how that so laboring ye

ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, **It is more blessed to give than to receive.** Ac.20:35

13. Hast thou faith? have it to thyself before God. **Happy is he that condemneth not himself in that thing which he alloweth.** Rom.15:22

14. **Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.** 1Cor.15:33

15. Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbor: for we are members one of another. **Be ye angry, and sin not:** let not the sun go down upon your wrath: neither give place to the devil. Eph.4:25-27

16. So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. **For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it,** even as the Lord the church: Eph.5:28,29

17. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which ye have both learned, and received,

and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you. Phil.4:8,9

18. I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me. Phil.4:13

19. But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another. And indeed ye do it toward all the brethren which are in all Macedonia : but we beseech you, brethren, that ye increase more and more; and that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you; that ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and that ye may have lack of nothing. 1Thes.4:9-12

20. Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feeble-minded, support the weak, be patient toward all men. See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men. Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. Abstain from all appearance of evil. 1Thes.5:14-22

21. Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, **comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.** 2Thes.2:16,17

22. I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may **lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.** For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. 1Tim.2:1-4

23. **But godliness with contentment is great gain.** For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. And having food and raiment, let us be therewith content. But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. 1Tim.6:6-10

24. **For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.** 2Tim.1:7

25. Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. 2Tim.2:15

26. Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, to speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, showing all meekness unto all men. Tit.3:1,2

27. For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous. For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. 1Jn.5:3,4
